

Conditions for Fishermen to Submit Applications for Marine Engines

MOCCAE will start receiving fishermen's orders for Mercury 150 hp marine engines from June 9, 2019 as per the following conditions:

Conditions

- 1. The gross salary of the fisherman does not exceed AED 30,000 (as per a salary certificate)
- 2. The fisherman did not receive any marine engine support between 2016 and 2018
- 3. The fisherman (applicant) is enlisted in the Ministry's public register prior to 2016
- 4. The fisherman (applicant) practices fishing as a permanent occupation, and MOCCAE will require proper verification
- 5. The fisherman has not committed an offense during 2018 for possessing or using prohibited fishing tools or equipment in accordance with the regulating laws

Required documents

- 1. A certified salary certificate or an affidavit from the court stating that the applicant fisherman is not working.
- 2. A full copy of the family book (if not available in the fisherman's file at the ministry or in the electronic system)
- 3. A copy of the Emirates ID card (if not available in the fisherman's file at the ministry or in the electronic system)

Priorities

- 1. Fishermen who practice fishing as a main profession
- 2. Fishermen who work on their own boats or have their relatives of 1st-4th degree working on their behalf

Guidelines

- 1. The supplier company shall not receive any money for the installation of the engines. This shall not include the cost of extra parts such as batteries and steering wheels, etc
- 2. The fisherman is given a one-month period, from the date of approval, to pay for the engine or else the request will be canceled

Period for receiving applications

Applications are accepted at fishing boats registration centers from 9 June - 11 July, 2019

Note

- 1. The engine is Mercury (150) hp
- 2. The value payable by the fisherman for one engine is (11,950) Dirhams
